MISSION

The mission of the CTE Resource Center is to support career and technical preparation programs by providing resources for curriculum development and program design and implementation in response to the Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act of 2006.

INTRODUCTION

The CTE Resource Center, located in Richmond, is funded by a state grant from the Office of Career and Technical Education Services, Virginia Department of Education. Administered by Henrico County Public Schools, the Center was established in 1982 to provide curriculum development and distribution services to the Department.

Since 1982, the Center has expanded its services and audiences for the benefit of its patrons. While numerous services are available to public schools and the Department of Education, five specifically address Virginia's curriculum initiative: search, development, printing, distribution, and in-service.

USE OF THE REPORT

In terms of the accountability report, each of the five services can be viewed as

DESCRIPTION OF CENTER SERVICES

The *information search* service is initiated with a research request from the Department of Education or the field. To perform this service, Center staff locate relevant information or materials within and beyond the Center's collection and route them to the patron. In addition, search is the precursor to other Center activities, reducing duplication of efforts, particularly in curriculum development and in-service.

In the *curriculum development* service, one of the original functions of the grant, Center writer/editors work with teachers, technical consultants, and business/industry representatives to develop competency-based curriculum materials in all areas of career and technical education.

Staff members write, edit, and design documents for a variety of media, but the majority of the Center's instructional frameworks now reside in Verso, Virginia's Educational Resource System Online. This dynamic Web-based system, created and managed by the Center, provides Virginia educators greater access to curriculum and

allows for extensive supporting resources for each course or program.

Printing is another major area of Center work. While online curriculum is becoming the norm, certain publications still require printing or CD duplication. Through this service, Center products are prepared for distribution in a selected medium to teachers and administrators.

Distribution, another original service offered since 1982, disseminates to educators Virginia-produced career and technical curriculum and promotional materials, VTECS software, and other items as identified by the Department of Education at no charge. The Center also maintains a lending library that provides Virginia's educators more than 7,000 additional print and AV resources on a loan basis.

The *in-service* area includes training programs and presentations by Center staff. These activities provide professional development opportunities for educators and encourage maximum use of Center materials and services.

a cost center. The cost center of Distribution is divided into two separate subcenters or minor categories: Lending Library and Dissemination. With the addition of a sixth area, general administration, almost all Center activities can be attributed to one of these cost centers or categories of service.

For the nineteenth year, the Center addressed the VTECS consortium obligations for the state of Virginia. VTECS activities are reflected in a seventh cost category.

While these seven cost centers have been labeled as services, each produces specific, tangible products. For the purpose of overall accountability, these products are listed in this report. No attempt has been made to quantify the Center's many intangible services.

In summary, seven major and two minor categories have been established to account for products and services provided by the Center in 2006/2007. For financial accounting purposes, these same categories can be viewed as cost centers, with personnel and operating costs associated with each.
