Eligibility Please Reference the Virginia FBLA Events at a Glance for Event Specific Information!

At the regional competition, each student may participate in

- one (1) objective test and one (1) performance event
 - Computer Applications is considered an objective test because it is school site tested and will not conflict with performance schedules; however, only top TWO students may advance to SLC.
 - Role Play events WITH A TEST COMPONENT such as Banking and Financial Systems are considered **performance**, even though the event is test only at the regional level (Unless the regional director communicates otherwise).

At the state competition, each student may participate in:

- one (1) objective test and one (1) performance event AND
- one (1) chapter event AND
- one (1) scholarship (scholarship interviews conducted prior to SLC)

Guidelines

Reference all event guidelines and the Virginia FBLA at a Glance document for specific event details on regional and state procedures. All national guidelines will be followed; however, SLC preliminary and final rounds are determined a bit differently.

- For all performance events, the regional competition is considered the preliminary round of competition.
- Events with a preliminary judged and preliminary test component have that preliminary component determine finalist. Finalists will be announced at the opening session if the event is conducted on Saturday and will be announced prior to the SLC if the event is conducted on Friday.

If a regional director decides to conduct an event differently, they will communicate that directly to their regional advisers.

Important State Change to Production Testing

Production tests will be given on site at the NLC but will remain school-site testing for the regional and state conferences.
