

# First Things First!

- → Family, Career, Community Leaders of America is the student leadership organization that allows every FCS program to be in compliance with state regulations
- November 1 is referred to as an <u>Early</u> Affiliation Deadline, however, affiliation can continue as needed throughout the rest of the year

## Choose to Make FCCLA a Priority

- → Make it visible in the classroom, around school, involve parents, and gain administrator support. We have many resources to help with this.
- → The FCS teacher is regarded as the <u>FCCLA adviser</u>-YOU, the ADVISER, are the key to <u>affiliated</u> membership and an active chapter. FCCLA is correctly carried out as part of <u>classroom instruction</u>.
- → Can only be called FCCLA and use the resources when dues submitted to national office....that's what affiliation means!
- Affiliation happens on the local, state, and national levels.



State competition is held during the day on Friday of state conference weekend. Events operate on three levels:



- → Level 1: through grade 8
  - → Level 2: grades 9-10
  - → Level 3: grades 11-12
