High Level Changes for the 2026 National Leadership Conference

For the High School Competitive Events program, the National FBLA Competitive Events Committee carefully analyzed state survey results, state course offerings, and state standards. The High School competitive events lineup was reviewed to ensure alignment with Middle School & Collegiate competitive events and career pathways. To guide our focus on career pathways, the Advance CTE's Career Cluster Framework was used as a foundational reference to inform the changes outlined in this document.

Overall Changes

- Refreshed rating sheets and streamlined scoring process
- Competencies & Tasks have been updated in some Objective Test events. These are now called Knowledge Areas and Objectives.
- Clarification of use of judge table
- Career Cluster Framework Connections have been added to the educational alignment areas.
- Additional NACE Competencies have been added to the educational alignment areas.
